Significant proceeds from this project were donated to Rainforest Action Network & Cultural Survival, both of whom were also beneficiaries from the Rainforest Benefit in New York in 1988.

She came back, the idea to take the band to play at the Great Pyramids in Giza was born. They took the whole show to Egypt in 1978.

I don't know if any of this stationary was ever officially used, but I seem to have some of every kind. I think it came from the offices of Grateful Dead Records.

It is autographed by all the musicians that were present at the recording session for Bob Weir’s music session for the Satchel Paige Music Project called “Pitchin’ Man” in April 1994. Bob Weir was not there as he became ill in New Orleans. There were many old time New Orleans jazz greats at this session, many of whom have now passed away. Of the 11 signatures, there is one that I have not identified. The studio was devastated by hurricane Katrina, and I don’t know the current status of the studio. Signatures I can identify:
